1. Accepted. All heirs have consented. Hence proclamation is dispensed with; the Petition is made returnable forthwith and is taken up for hearing and final disposal.

The Petitioner seeks a Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of one Carmen Felix Coutinho alias Tertuliana Gloriana Dalgado, who is said to have died intestate in Goa, on 5th October 2015. A copy of her death certificate is annexed. During her lifetime, the deceased was ordinarily resident in Mumbai.
