2. The Petitioner seeks a Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of one Deepak Sadashiv Bandisode, who is said to have died intestate in Mumbai, where he was ordinarily resident, on 17th February 2014. A copy of his death certificate is annexed.

6. All the heirs have consented. No other Petition for a heirship certificate, succession certificate, probate or letters of administration with or without will annexed has been filed. There is no impediment to the grant of relief.
