1. The Court Receiver's Report is allowed in terms of prayer Clauses (a) and (b), which are reproduced hereunder :

“(a) Court Receiver be discharged without passing accounts and Plaintiff may be directed to pay costs, charges and expenses of the office of the Court Receiver, High Court, Bombay ;
