The Petitioner seeks a Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of one Minoo Faredoon Madon, who is said to have died intestate in Mumbai, where he was ordinarily resident, on 2nd December 2012. A copy of his death certificate is annexed. The deceased was survived by the heirs whose names are set out in the tabulation below paragraph 2 of the petition.

2. The Legal Heirship Certificate is required in relation to tax returns.

3. All the heirs have consented. Their consent Affidavits are at pages 26 to 29 of the Petition. No other Petition for a heirship

certificate, succession certificate, probate or letters of administration with or without will annexed has been filed. There is no impediment to the grant of relief. The proclamation was dispensed with.
