1. Accepted. There is no other heir other than the Petitioner. Hence proclamation is dispensed with, the Petition is made returnable forthwith and is taken up for hearing and final disposal.

2. The Petitioner seeks a Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of one Sunita Gurappa Bidnur, who is said to have died intestate in Mumbai, where he was ordinarily resident, on 19th April 2012. A copy of his death certificate is annexed. The Petitioner is the only heir of the deceased. His name is mentioned in the tabulation below paragraph 4 of the petition.

3. The deceased during her life time was a owner and occupant of the Room No. J-81, situated at Sanjay Gandhi Nagar, Plot No.267, General A.K. Vaidya Marg, Malad (East), Mumbai 400 097. This is a part of a SRA scheme. The heirship certificate is required for submission to the authorities in respect of that redevelopment.
4. No other Petition for a heirship certificate, succession certificate, probate or letters of administration with or without will annexed has been filed. There is no impediment to the grant of relief.
5. The petition is made absolute in terms of prayer clause (a).
