1. None appears on behalf of the Appellant. We had directed the office to issue notice to the parties. The Appellant is aggrieved by an order dated 14th November, 2005 passed by the learned Single Judge in Summons for Judgment No. 192 of 2005. The suit was decreed with costs since the learned Single Judge was of the view that there was no defence in the suit.

2. There was no stay granted by this Court to the hearing of

the suit. It appears that Appellant is not keen in pursuing the appeal.
