Kennelworth Mall, situated at Plot No. 505, 506, C.T.S. No. F-137, 138 of village Bandra, T.P.S. III, 33rd Road, Linking Road, Bandra West, Mumbai – 400 050.
- (d) Interims and ad-interims in terms of prayers a to c.
- (e) For the cost of the petition.
