1. On 24th February, 2016, this Court passed the following order :

“1. By consent of the parties, Mr. Minoo Siodia, Advocates and Solicitors, is proposed to be appointed as the sole Arbitrator to decide the disputes between the parties arising out of the works awarded to the Applicant vide letter of acceptance dated 30th January, 1986 issued by the Respondent. In view thereof, Mr. Minoo Siodia, Advocate and Solicitor shall submit disclosure under Section 11 (8) read with Section 12 (1) of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

2. The Advocates for the parties shall forward a copy of this order to Mr. Minoo Siodia, Advocate and Solicitor.

3.All concerned to act on an ordinary copy of this order, duly authenticated by the learned Associate of this Court.

4.Stand over to 26th February, 2016 .”

2. Pursuant to the above order, Mr.Minoo Siodia, Advocate and Solicitor, has filed disclosure under Section 11(8) read with Section 12(1) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The same is taken on record and the following order is passed by consent :

i. The disputes between the parties arising out of works awarded to the Applicant vide letter of acceptance dated 30th January 1986 issued by the Respondent, are referred to the sole Arbitration of Mr. Minoo Siodia, Advocate and Solicitors.

ii. The parties shall appear before the learned Arbitrator in his chambers, on 2nd March, 2016 at 5.00 p.m. and obtain necessary directions.

iii. The cost of arbitration shall initially be borne by the parties equally.

iv. All contentions of the parties are kept open.

v. The venue of Arbitration shall be at Mumbai.

3. In view of this order, the above Arbitration Petition is disposed of.
