1. On 27th January, 2016 this Court passed the following order :

“1. The disputes in the above Arbitration Application are proposed to be referred to Mrs. Justice Sujata V. Manohar (Former Judge of the Supreme Court of India). In view thereof, Mrs. Justice Sujata V. Manohar, shall submit disclosure under Section 11 (8) read with Section 12 (1) of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

2. The Advocates for the parties shall forward a copy of this order to Justice Mrs. Justice Sujata V. Manohar.

3. All concerned to act on an ordinary copy of this order, duly authenticated by the learned Associate of this Court.

4. Stand over to 5th February, 2016.”

2. Pursuant to the above order, Mrs. Justice Sujata V. Manohar (Former Judge of the Supreme Court of India) has filed disclosure under Section 11(8) read with Section 12(1) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The same is taken on record and the following order is passed by consent :

- i. The disputes arising out of the Indian Premier League Media Rights License Agreement dated 25th March, 2009 between the parties are referred to the sole Arbitration of Mrs. Justice Sujata V. Manohar, (Former Judge of the Supreme Court of India).
 - ii. The parties shall appear before the learned Arbitrator in her chambers, on 10th February, 2016 at 5.30 p.m. and obtain necessary directions.
 - iii. The cost of arbitration shall initially be borne by the parties equally.
 - iv. All contentions of the parties are kept open.
 - v. The venue of Arbitration shall be at Mumbai.
3. In view of this order, the above Arbitration Application is disposed of.
