The only prayer made by the petitioner is for the direction to the respondent No.2-Collector to implement the order of the Hon'ble Minister, dated 31/07/2014 and refund the amount towards the unexcavated quantity of sand.

It is the case of the petitioner that despite the decision of the Hon'ble Minister, dated 31/07/2014 to take appropriate steps in the matter of refunding the amount to the petitioner towards the unexcavated sand, the respondent No.2-Collector has not released the amount in favour of the petitioner till date.

Shri Rode, the learned Assistant Government Pleader, states on instructions from the respondent No.2-Collector, Bhandara that the requisite amount would be paid to the petitioner within a period of two months.

By accepting the statement made by the learned Assistant Government Pleader, which would be binding on the respondent No.2-Collector, we dispose of the writ petition with no order as to costs.
