Shri Vyas, learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing the writ petition for some time, on instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to challenge the order of termination dated 1.7.2013, as disclosed by the respondents in their reply.

Shri M. Anilkumar, learned counsel for the respondents, submits that if any liberty is granted, the legal rights of the respondents should be protected to enable them to oppose the proceedings on merits/delay.
