The applicant is arrested on 26-09-2015 in crime registered against him for offences punishable under Sections 294, 324 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code on the accusations that the applicant gave blow of axe to the daughter of complainant, wife of complainant and to the complainant and all of them suffered injuries.

3. The learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted that the incident had taken place because of sudden quarrel between the applicant and the family of complainant who are neighbours. The learned Advocate for the applicant has stated that the applicant will be residing at Nagpur with his relatives till the trial is complete.

Considering the nature of incident, the facts on record and as the non-applicant has not been able to show that custody of the applicant is required for further investigation, in my view, the applicant is entitled to be released on bail, however, on certain conditions.

4. Hence, the following order :

- i) The applicant having been arrested in Crime No.114/2015 registered by the non-applicant, he be released on bail on furnishing P.R. Bond for Rs.10,000/- and one solvent surety in the like amount.
- ii) Till the trial is complete, the applicant shall not enter village Girgaon, Tahsil-Nagbhid, District Chandrapur and will stay at Nagpur, as suggested on behalf of the applicant.
- iii) The applicant shall regularly attend the sessions trial unless granted exemption by the Sessions Court.
- iv) The application is allowed in the above terms.
