By the present application, the applicant seeks condonation of delay of 223 days caused in filing the appeal. Notices were issued. No reply is filed. Respondent No.1 is reported to be dead.

If the entire decretal amount is not deposited within a period of four weeks from today, the interim order shall stand vacated and the Executing Court shall be at liberty to execute the decree expeditiously.

The civil application stands disposed of.
