Learned counsel appearing for the parties submit that as the petition challenges the order of injunction and the parties are of the opinion that instead of prosecuting the petition for some more time, it will be in the interest of parties to request for deciding the suit pending before the lower Court within reasonable period. The request is reasonable one. No prejudice is caused to any parties. On the contrary, interest of justice would be met and the proceedings itself would come to an end instead of fighting in this Court against some interim order.
