Heard Shri A.B. Tikle with Shri Parag Wagh, learned counsel for the applicant, Shri S.D. Sonak, learned APP for non-applicant No. 1 and Shri R.R. Gour, learned counsel (appointed) for non-applicant No. 2.

We are not inclined to intervene in extraordinary jurisdiction as the approach is after more than two years.
