The learned Counsel for the petitioner has tendered a

It is stated on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner is desirous of challenging the action on the part of the
respondent – University before the Commissioner for
Handicapped. It is stated that the relief sought by prayer
clause nos.(ii) to (iv) are rendered infructuous.

Shri Patil, the learned Counsel for the respondent –
University states that the petitioner has already approached the
Commissioner for Handicapped and the order passed in favour of
