Heard Ms. Vidhya Umale, the learned Advocate for the applicant and Shri Rohit Joshi, the learned Advocate for the non-applicant Nos.1 and 3.

The learned Advocates for the respective parties are *ad idem* regarding appointment of an Arbitrator other than the Divisional Commissioner as per Clause 31 of the agreement.

Hence, the following order :

Shri A.V. Bhide, Advocate, W.H.C. Road, Dharampeth, Nagpur is appointed as an Arbitrator to resolve the dispute between the parties.

The applicant and the non-applicant Nos.1 and 3 shall deposit Rs.20,000/- each with the Registry of this Court within four weeks towards security of fees of the learned Arbitrator.

In addition, the applicant and the non-applicants shall pay fees of the learned Arbitrator.

The applicant shall deposit Rs.5,000/- with the Registry of this Court within a period of four weeks towards processing charges.

The application is allowed accordingly.
