The learned counsel for the petitioners and the respondent nos.4 and 5 have tendered a joint *pursis* in the Court, today. The same is accepted on record.

The joint *pursis* is signed by the petitioners nos. 1 and 2 and the respondent nos. 4 and 5 as also their respective counsel. It is stated in the *pursis* that due to misunderstanding between the members in the Management, the salary bills of the petitioners since April, 2016 were not sent to the Education Officer immediately and now since the differences are sorted out, the same are sent to the Education Officer. It is stated that in view of the aforesaid settlement, the grievance of the petitioner would not survive.

By accepting the statements made by the learned counsel for the petitioners and the respondent nos. 4 and 5 and the statements made in the joint *pursis*, we dispose of the Writ Petition with a direction to the respondent no.3 to release the unpaid salary to the petitioners as early as possible.

Order accordingly. No costs.
