labour for specific works has been allotted to
respondent no.2 by respondent no.1.

expires sometimes in the month of July 2016.

In this situation, the petitioner at the most
can recover damages for injury, if any, sustained by

it. We are not inclined to examine merits of the controversy in writ jurisdiction.

Keeping all rival contentions open and with liberty to petitioner to take such other steps as are open to it in law, we dispose of the petition. No costs.
