There is a delay of 615 days caused in filing an appeal challenging the order passed by the Reference Court enhancing the compensation. Notices were served. The claimants are served. Reply is filed opposing the application for condonation of delay.

The delay has been caused due to some administrative reasons, which I find to be the sufficient cause in the absence of lack of *bona fides* and the claimants can be compensated by payment of costs.

In the result, the civil application is allowed. The delay caused is condoned. The appellant to pay costs of Rs.5,000/- to the respondents-claimants.

The civil application stands disposed of.
