The necessary details explaining the inordinate delay in complying with the order regarding deposit of the amount are not given in the application. If the amount is not deposited within one week, the interim order shall stand vacated without reference to Court.

After the amount is deposited, the respondent Nos.2 to 4/claimants are permitted to withdraw 50% of the amount on furnishing undertaking to the satisfaction

of the learned Registrar (Judicial) of this Court and the balance 50% amount be given to the respondent Nos.2 and 4 on furnishing solvent surety/security to the satisfaction of the learned Registrar (Judicial) of this Court. The amount be disbursed to the respondent Nos.2 to 4 in equal proportion.
