Gondia, against the applicant, the respondent - Police Station Officer, Police Station, Amgaon, Distt. Gondia, is directed to release the applicant on bail, upon the Applicant furnishing a Personal Bond in a sum of Rs. 10,000/- [rupees ten thousand only] with one surety in the like amount.
