Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issue of a writ of Mandamus, forbearing the respondents 3 to 5 from converting and changing the character of the land in Town S.No.438/1B situate at Chinnamelamayur Village, Gundur Ward No.3 within Chengalpattu Municipality bounded on East by G.S.T.Road, West by Gandipan Vedachalam Street, north by T.S.No.438/2 Iyankulam and south by T.S.No.437/2 Porpandal Arumuga Mudaliar Vagaiyara Bungalow admeasuring north to south on the eastern side $25 \frac{1}{2} + 9'$, north to south on the western side $34 \frac{1}{2}' + 10'$, east to west on the northern side 149', east to west on the southern side $78 + 78 \frac{1}{2}$ of an extent of 8086 sq.ft which was allotted for the secular purpose of construction of school and for the benefit of Thondai Mandala Thuluva Vellalar people and for the construction of building for auspicious ceremonies exclusively not related to the religious character of Arulmighu Chinnamuthu Mariamman

Temple in the same Town Survey Number as (ii) item of the Gift deed dated 15.07.1981 in Doc.No.429/1981 within S.R.O Chengalpattu by Kamalakannan Mudaliar for religious activities or performance of religious obligation in the said property.
