Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issue of a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to disburse the payments relating to Gratuity, Leave Encashment and calculating D.A. eligible as per newly implemented, with interest at 12% per annum with effect from 01.07.2013 within the stipulated time.

ORDER

The petitioner, Mr.D.Kesari Varman, has filed this writ petition for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to disburse the payments relating to Gratuity, Leave Encashment and calculating D.A. eligible as per newly implemented, with interest at 12% per annum with effect from 01.07.2013 within the stipulated time.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner. Mr.P.Paramasivados, learned standing counsel takes notice on behalf of the respondents.

3. The petitioner joined as Conductor on 22.01.1990 in the Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation Limited, Villupuram and

retired as Senior Assistant on 30.6.2013 while working in Region office of the second respondent Corporation. Now the grievance of the petitioner is that his retirement benefits, namely, gratuity, leave Encashment etc., have not been till date settled by the respondents.

4. Since the issue is squarely covered by the various orders passed by this Court, in the light of the Hon'ble Division Bench judgment in W.A.(MD) Nos.383 to 457 of 2015 dated 12.6.2015 (K.Rajendran and others v. The Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation (Madurai) Limited represented by its Managing Director, Madurai and others), this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to settle the entire terminal benefits due and payable to the petitioner through twelve equal monthly instalments carrying interest of 6% p.a. The first instalments should commence from April, 2016 and each of the instalments should be paid on or before 7th of each month. In case of any delay in the payment of the instalments, the interest payable would become 18% p.a. for the delayed period apart from any other remedy which may be available to the petitioner for such non-payment of the instalments. No costs.
