further orders are necessary in this Habeas Corpus Petition.

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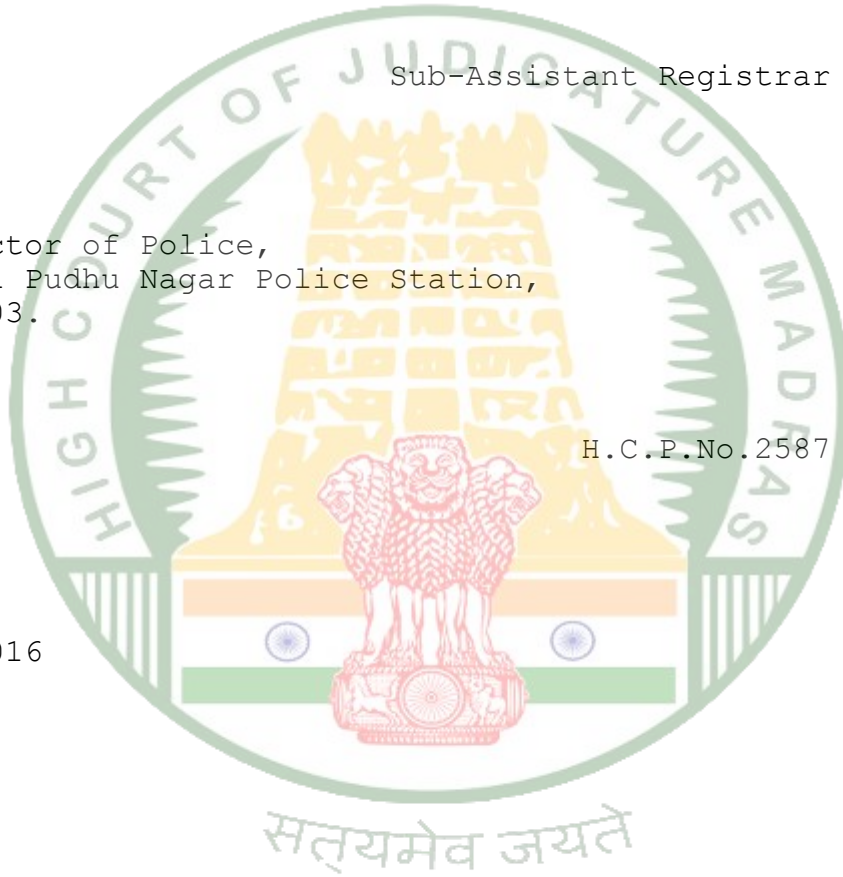
