case in Crime No.3080 of 2015 has been registered by the
respondent police on 22.10.2015.

Public Prosecutor submits that the detenue was secured on
07.11.2015 and handed over to her parents. He also produced the
case diary and we perused the same.

4. In view of the above, nothing further survives in this petition and accordingly, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed.

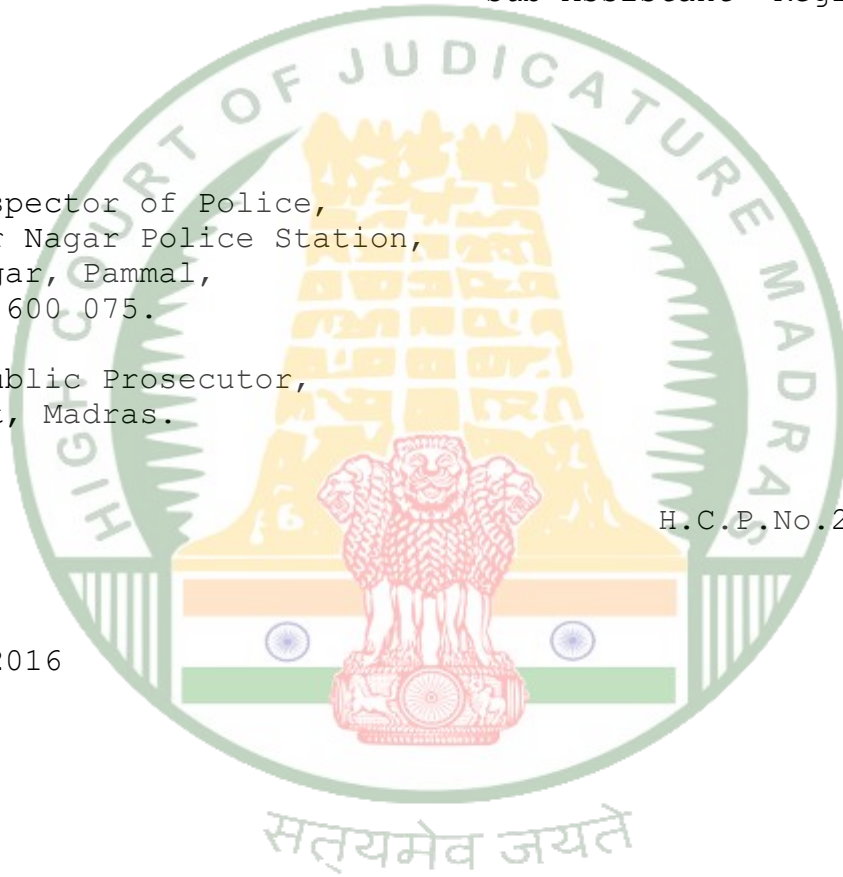
