1. The Defacto Complainant paid a sum of Rs.2,25,000/- (Rupees two lakhs and twenty five thousand only) towards full and final settlement to the 1st Petitioner and 1st Petitioner acknowledges the receipt of the same.
2. Defacto Complainant has agreed that he has received all his jewel worth 15 sovereigns and the original land document pertaining to his land from the 1st Petitioner.
3. The Defacto complainant agrees to withdraw the complaint in Cr.No.410/2016 pending before the Inspector of Police, Mannarugudi Town Police Station, Thiruvavarur District.
4. Both parties agree that they have no further claim against each other.
