Learned Government Advocate further submits that the petitioner's husband was also arrested in the said case.

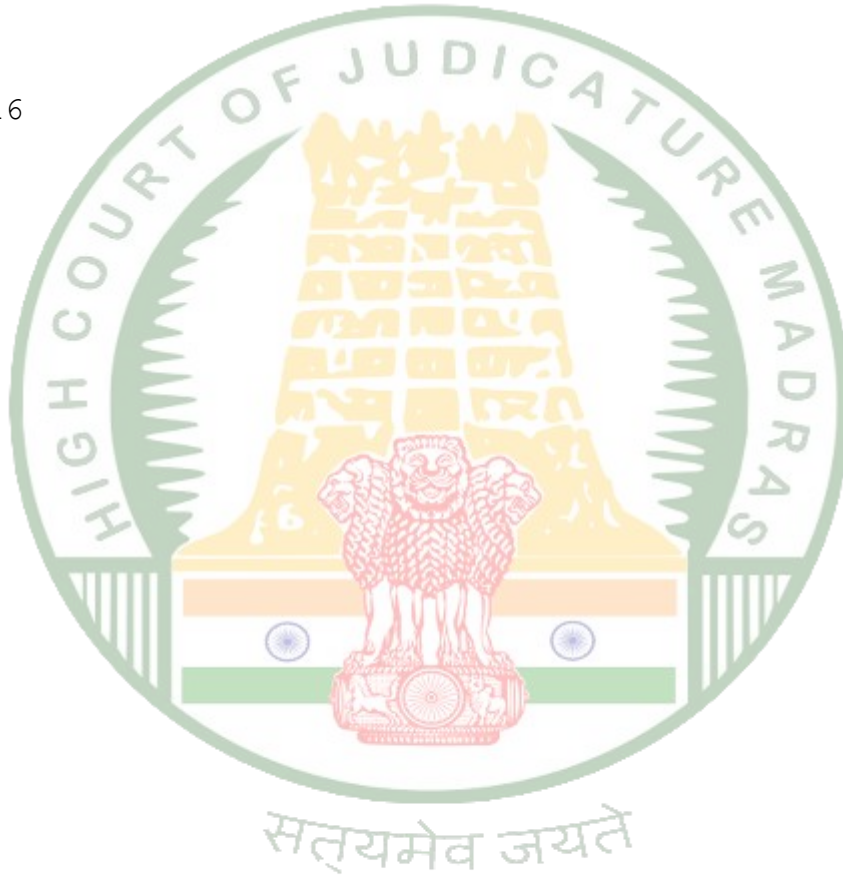
