Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side and taking into consideration the limited prayer sought for by the petitioner, without expressing any opinion with regard to the merits of the case, I direct the respondent to receive the application of the petitioner dated 05.03.2016 in Form CCPA and the prescribed fee for the grant of Maxi Cab permit and consider the same on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With this observation, the writ petition is disposed of.

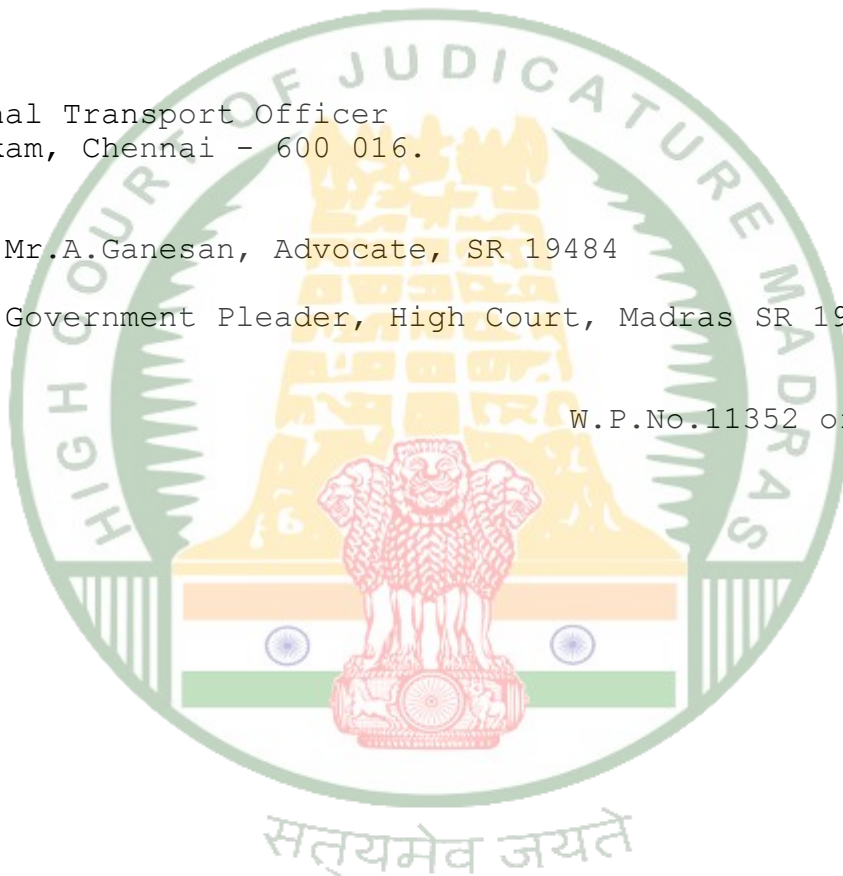
