306, 201 I.P.C., read with 3(1)(x), 3(1)(xi), 3(2)(v) of S.C. & S.T. r/w 3(2)(vii) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 r/w 109 IPC and that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the said Act, the petitioners cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioners have come forward with the said prayer.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) takes notice for the respondents.

4. Considering the submissions of both sides and also considering the nature of the prayer in this case in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the S.C. & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act that the petitioners cannot move any anticipatory bail, the learned District & Sessions Judge, Perambalur, is directed to consider the bail application, in the event of the petitioners filing such petition in Crime No. 1 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police, and dispose of the same on merits and in accordance with law on the same day.

With this observation, this petition is disposed of accordingly.
