3(i) (c) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities Act,) Amendment Ordinance, 2016 and that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the said Act, the petitioners cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioner has come forward with the said prayer.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) takes notice for the respondents and he further submits that injured has been discharged from the hospital.

4. Considering the submissions of both sides and also considering the nature of the prayer in this case in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the S.C. & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act that the petitioner cannot move any anticipatory bail, the learned Principal and District Judge, Tiruvannamalai, is directed to consider the bail application, in the event of the petitioners filing such petition in Crime No. 343 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police, and dispose of the same on merits and in accordance with law on the same day.

With this observation, this petition is disposed of accordingly.
