We may note that one year time period is sought for clearing the water area of the encroachments and other constructions, excluding the structures (tabular column Sl. Nos.1 to 7) mentioned in paragraph 5. Thus, we would like to monitor the progress in this behalf with a periodic status report being filed showing the compliances along with map of the area and photographs.

2. The writ petition, accordingly, stands disposed of. No costs.

4. The compliance report be filed atleast three days prior to the next date of hearing with advance copy to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Needless to say, the interim direction made on 09.06.2016 to form part of the final direction.

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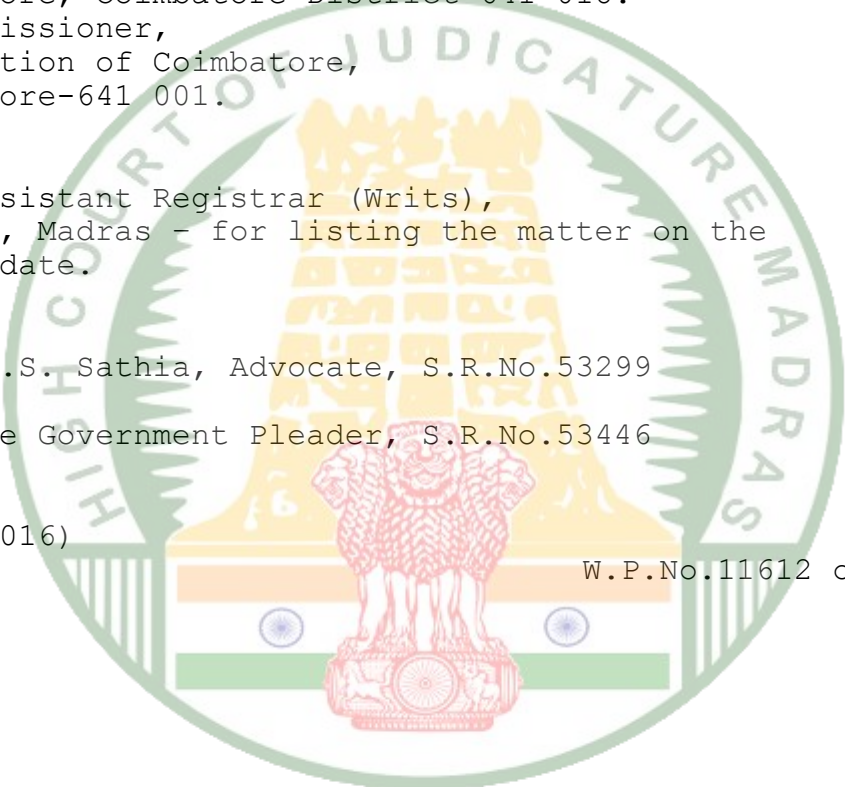
