1. Mr.Manishkumar, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1 / original applicant. He says, he does not wish to file a reply to the application, and that, he does not oppose the relief prayed for, by the applicant / original respondent.

2. To be noted, prohibitory order dated 16.02.2015 was passed in Application no.344 of 2015, whereby the respondent no.2 / garnishee was restrained from paying the amount, claimed by respondent no.1 / original applicant.

3. Mr.Pradeepkumar, learned counsel for the respondent no.1 / original applicant says that since payments have been made since then by the applicant, he has no objection to the prohibitory order being raised.
