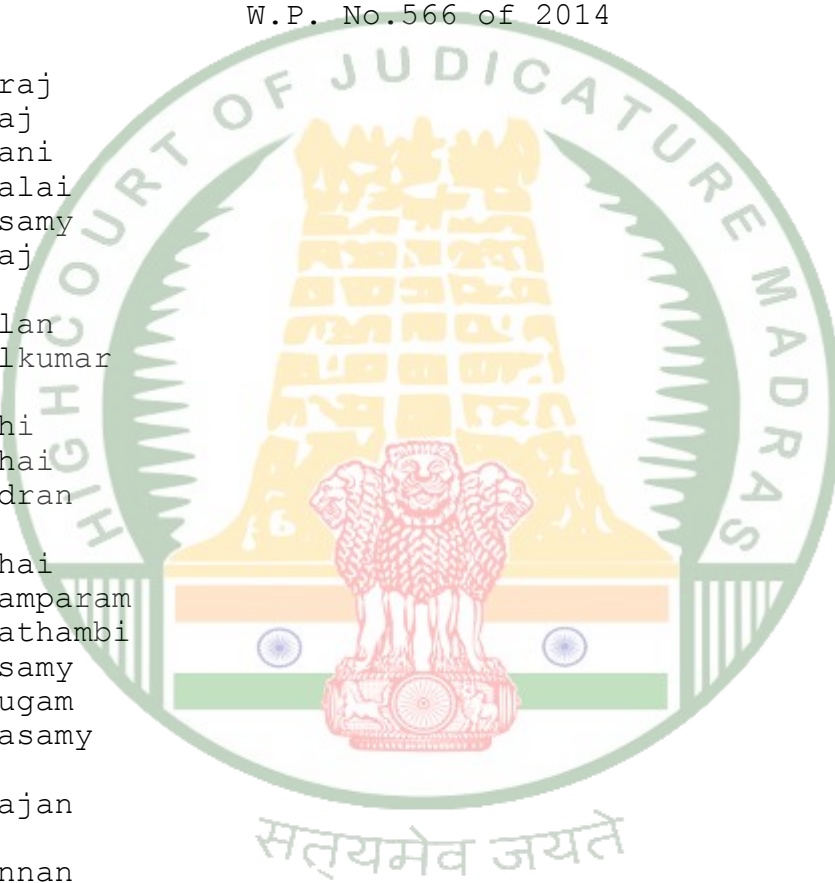

2.It is, thus, agreed that if the petitioners, in support of their plea, want to furnish any further material, they may do so within one (1) month from today. The respondent authorities will take a decision on the same within a maximum period of three (3) months thereafter, after holding a proper enquiry.

3.Writ petition, accordingly, stands disposed of. No costs.

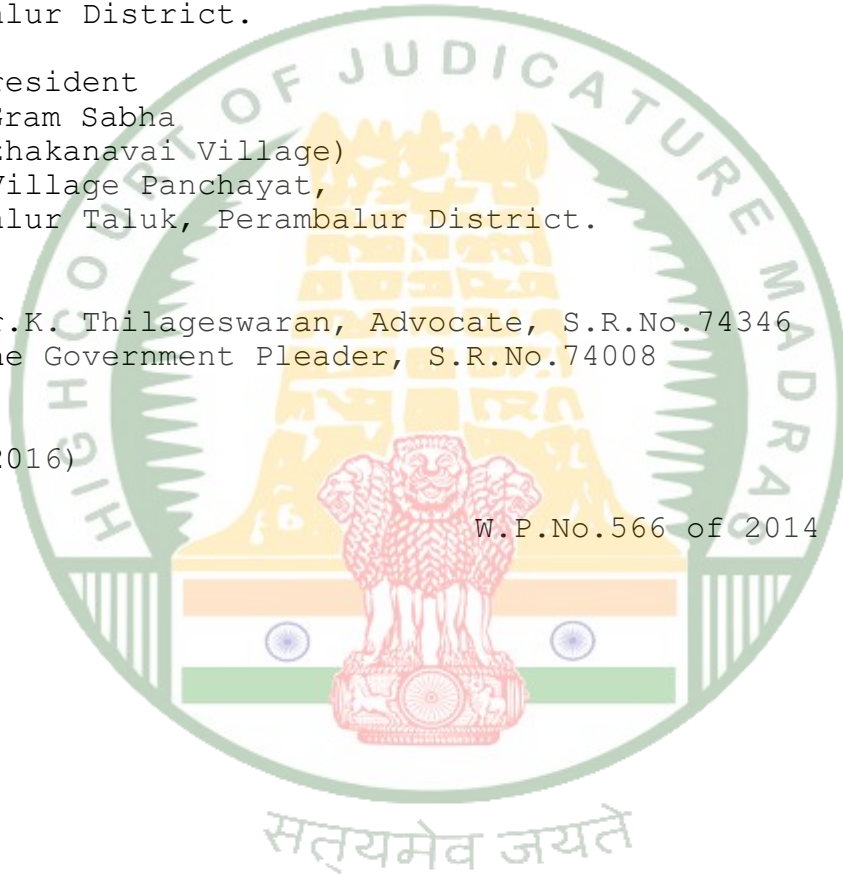
