4.Hence, the petitioner is directed to give a fresh complaint to the respondent police within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on receipt of the same, the respondent police is directed to conduct enquiry within a period of four weeks thereafter and during the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, F.I.R. shall be registered, following the dictum laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme

Court in LALITA KUMARI vs. GOVERNMENT OF UTTARPRADESH AND OTHERS reported in [(2014) 2 SCC 1].

5.With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is closed.

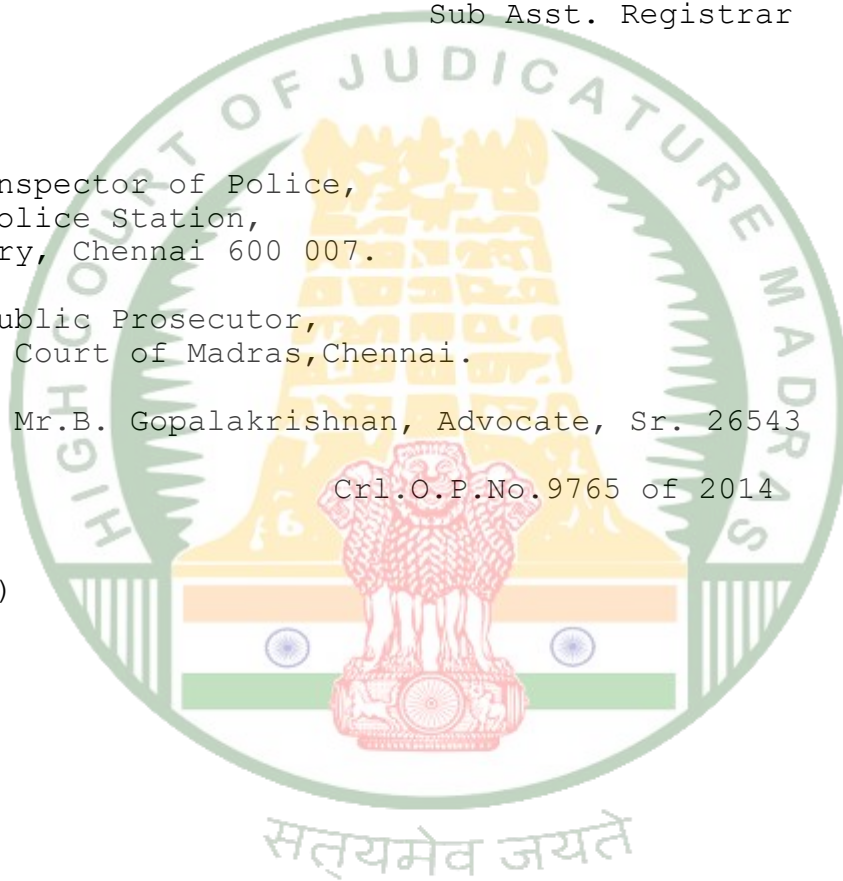
