ORDER

By consent, the main writ petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

2. After making submissions on merit, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that as the order under challenge is appealable to the Joint Director of School Education, (Higher Secondary), Directorate of School Education, Chennai, liberty may be given to exhaust the said remedy.

3. Considering the same, the petitioner is given four weeks time to file such an appeal. As and when, such an appeal, if any, is received from the petitioner, the Joint Director of School Education, (Higher Secondary), Directorate of School Education, Chennai, is directed to consider and dispose of the same within a period of three months thereafter, after affording an opportunity to the parties concerned. Till then, status quo, as on today, shall be maintained. However, it is made clear that the interim order of status quo shall not have any bearing on the disposal of the main appeal.

4. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
