This contempt petition is filed alleging non-compliance of the order dated 12 November 2013 passed in W.P. No.17940 of 2013.

2 The respondent/alleged contemner, viz., the Tahsildar, Thiruvannamalai, has filed an affidavit dated 09 January 2016, stating that the encroachment made in S.No.75/12, 13 and 14, Su. Nallur Village, Thiruvannamalai

District, has been removed on 06 January 2016 and thus, the aforestated order passed by this Court has been complied with.

3 However, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the encroachment has not been removed in its entirety and a portion of the encroachment is yet to be removed.

4 If it is so, the respondent is directed to remove the encroachment in full within a further period of four weeks.

This contempt petition stands closed with the aforestated direction.
