ORDER

This Court, in Crl.O.P. No.10618 of 2015, on 28.04.2015, passed the following order:

"3. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side and taking into account the nature of allegations in the complaint, a blanket direction to file a final report cannot be given and instead, it would be in the interest of justice, a direction is issued to the respondent police to conduct enquiry and complete the investigation and either file a final report or closure report with due notice to the de facto complainant as the case may be, as expeditiously as possible."
