The writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issue of a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents herein to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 10.11.2014 submitted in respect of the regularization of service of the petitioner, in view of G.O.(2D)No.62, Public Works Department, dated 6.11.2014, regularizing the services of Mr.G.Duraipandian and pass such further orders.

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, as well as the learned counsel, appearing on behalf of the respondents.

2 This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner, praying that this Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents herein to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 10.11.2014, with regard to the regularization of the service of the petitioner, within a stipulated time.

3 Though various grounds have been raised in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that it would suffice, if the second respondent is directed to dispose of the representation, dated 10.11.2014, on merits and in accordance with law, within a specified period.

4 In view of the averments made in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition and in view of the submissions made by the learned counsel, appearing on behalf of the petitioner, this Court finds it appropriate to direct the second respondent to dispose of the representation of the petitioner, dated 10.11.2014, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. The petitioner shall furnish a copy of the representation, dated 10.11.2014, to the second respondent, along with a copy of this order. However, it is made clear that this Court, by this order, has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter.

5 The writ petition is disposed of, with the above directions. No costs.

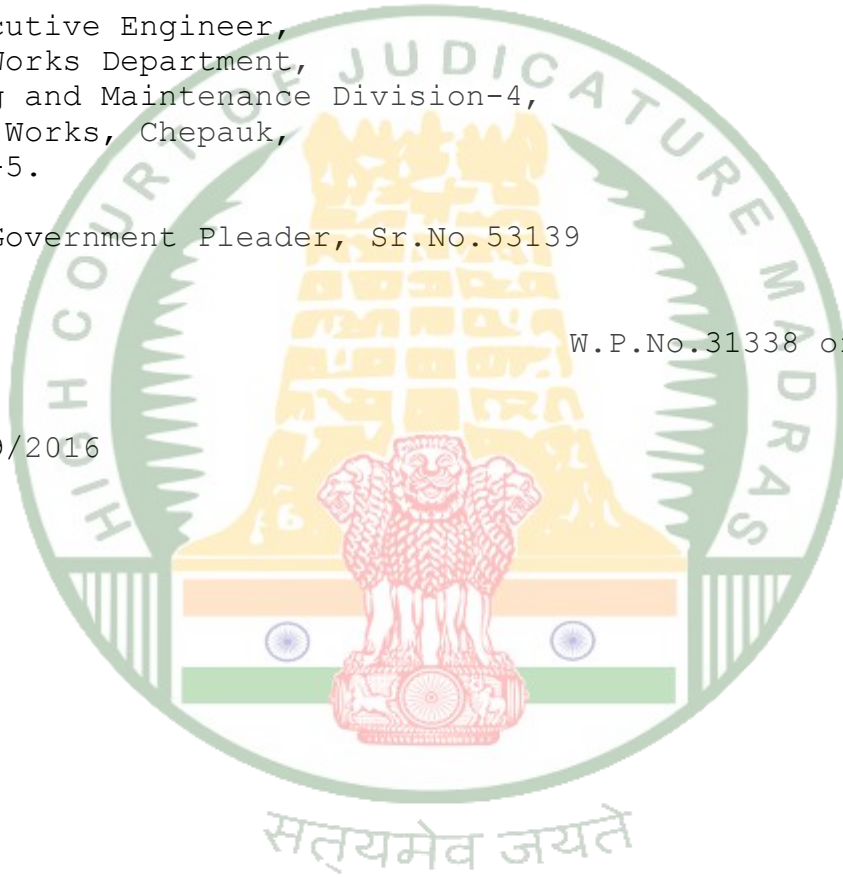
