2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners as well as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

Considering the nature of the prayer sought for and taking note of the fact that the petitioners are prepared to surrender before the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Tiruppur, there shall be a direction to the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Tiruppur, to consider the bail application to be submitted by the petitioners along with their

surrender before that Court, on the same day on merits and pass appropriate orders. The criminal original petition is ordered accordingly.
