4.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it is purely a religious festival and further he undertakes absolutely there will not be any kind of political canvassing.

5. The said statement of the learned counsel for the petitioner is recorded. The petitioner is at liberty to proceed with the festival as per the undertaking given before this Court.

6.The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
