Government of Uttarpradesh and Others reported in [2014] 2 SCC 1, otherwise close the complaint under intimation to the petitioner.

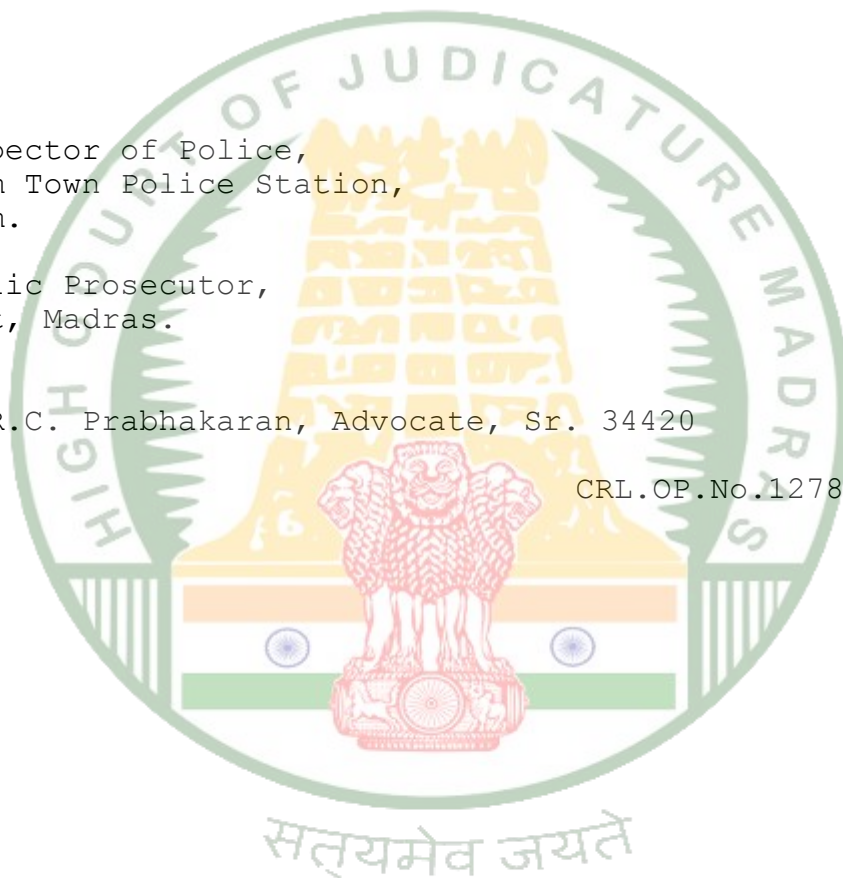
