O R D E R

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has come forward with this petition seeking for a direction to the learned District and Sessions Judge, Perambalur to consider the bail application of the petitioner on the same day on his surrender in Crime No.1 of 2015 pending on the file of the respondent.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the petitioner has been implicated in this case for the alleged offences under Sections 147, 348, 294[b], 323, 325, 355, 354, 114, 166, 167, 218, 506[i], 306, 201 of IPC r/w 3[1][x], 3[1][xi], 3[2][v], 3[2][vii] of SC & ST [Prevention of Atrocities] Act r/w 109 IPC and that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the said Act, the petitioner cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioner has come forward with the said prayer.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice for the respondent.

4. It is seen that co-accused/A3 to A5 has been granted same relief in Crl.OP.No.11189 of 2016 by this Court on 26.05.2016.

5. Considering the submissions of both sides and also considering the nature of the prayer in this case in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the SC & ST [Prevention of Atrocities] Act that the petitioner cannot move any anticipatory bail, the learned District and Sessions Judge, Perambalur is directed to consider the bail application, in the event of the petitioner filing such petition in Crime No.1 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police, and dispose of the same on merits, in accordance with law on the same day.

With this observation, this petition is disposed of accordingly.
