In this regard, the respondent police has conducted an enquiry in CSR No.444 of 2016 and the same has been closed on the undertaking given by his son that he would care of him. After giving such an undertaking, the petitioner's son is continuing to harass him.

Under such circumstances, the criminal original petition is closed with liberty to the petitioner to approach the concerned authority under Senior Citizens Act.

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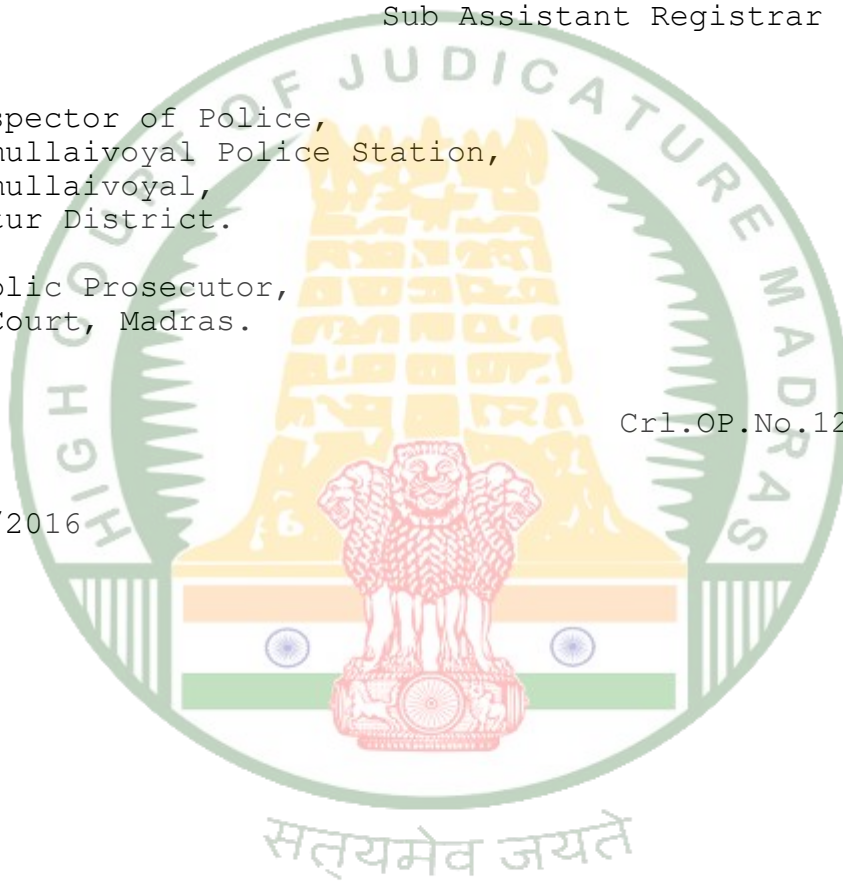
