

Crl.O.P.No.13049 of 2016

G.CHOCKALINGAM, J.

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A-1 to A-4, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294[b], 323 and 506[i] of IPC in Crime No.263 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on account of land dispute, the petitioners assaulted the de facto complainant with sticks, due to which, the victim sustained injuries and was hospitalized.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4.The learned Government Advocate [Criminal Side] appearing for the respondent submitted that the victim has been discharged from the hospital and there is no previous case as against these petitioners.

5.Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the victim has been discharged from the hospital and there is no previous case as against these petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

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6. Accordingly, it is ordered that the petitioners shall be released on bail, in the event of arrest or on their surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Katpadi, within a period of ten days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, subject to the following conditions:-

(i) Each petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the arresting Officer or to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Katpadi; and on further condition that

(ii) The petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders.

(iii) If the petitioners fail to comply with any one of the above conditions imposed by this Court, the anticipatory bail granted shall stand automatically dismissed without any further reference to this Court.
