3. It is seen that, on a complaint lodged by one T.D.Ravi and N.Gopi, against this petitioner, petition enquiry is pending before the respondent.

4. In view of the above, the respondent Police is directed not to harass the petitioner. The petitioner shall co-operate in the enquiry. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the respondent police is free to register an FIR and this order shall not be a shield for the petitioner against arrest.

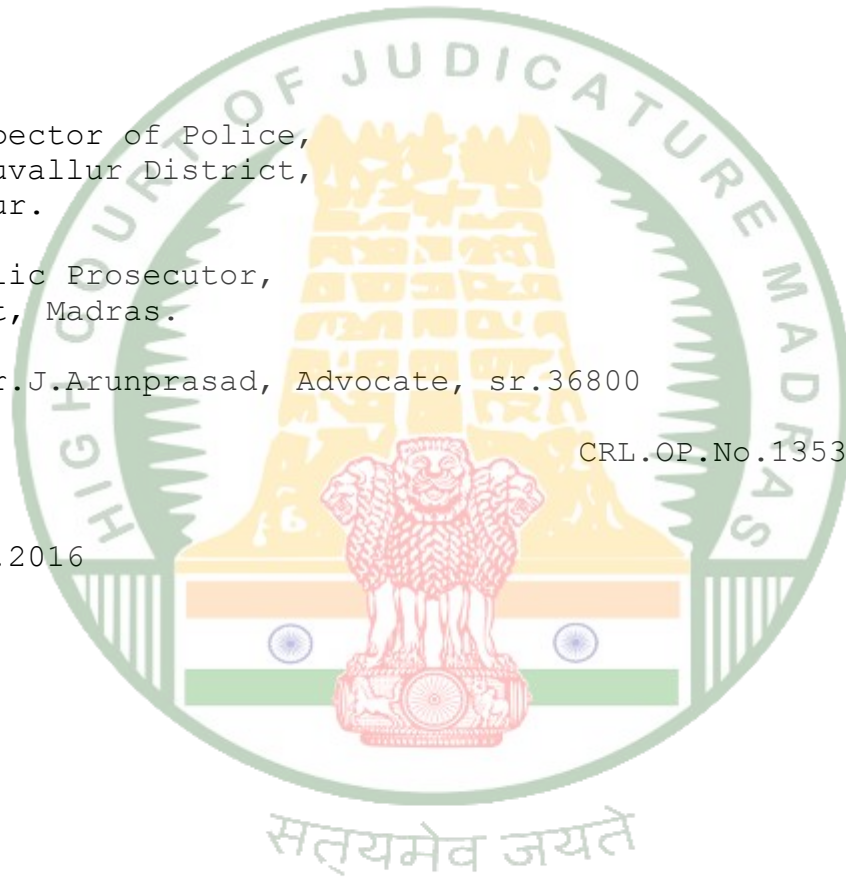
