COMMON ORDER

These writ petitions are filed by the employees of the Indian Overseas Bank, seeking to forbear the management from proceeding with the departmental action initiated against them. The challenge was made on the short ground that criminal proceedings are pending before the Trial Court on the very same set of facts and allegations.

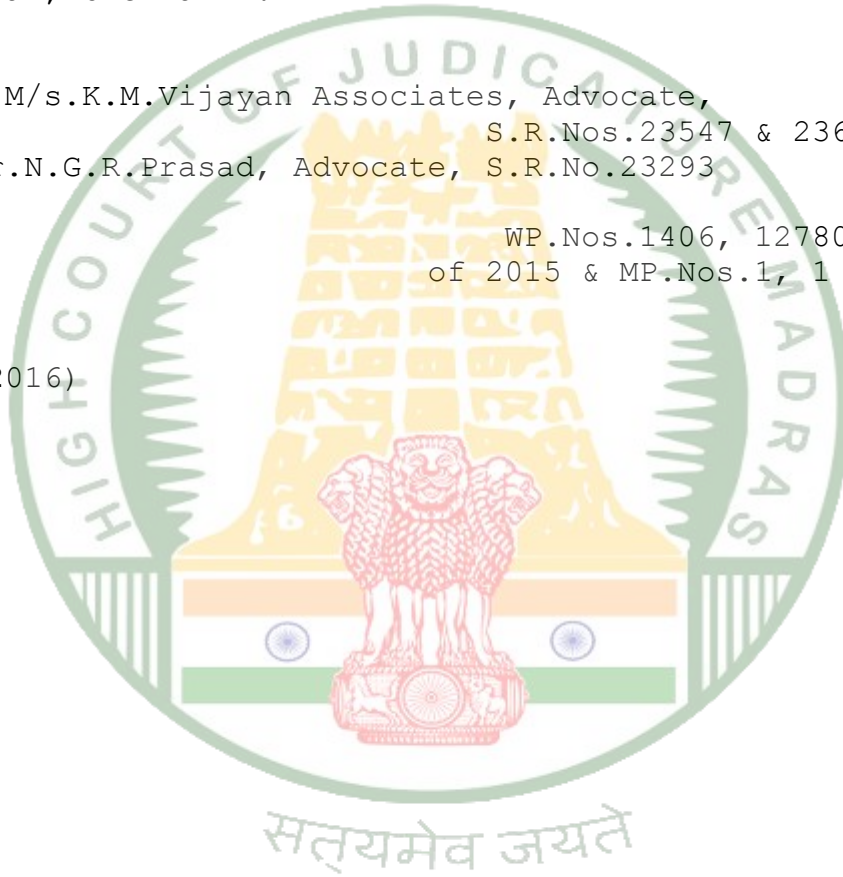
