Learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that on the complaints dated 15.06.2016 and 03.07.2016 given by the petitioner and the complaint dated 03.07.2016 given by the opposite party, petition enquiry was conducted in CSR.No.141 of 2016 by calling the opposite party and the same has been closed as dispute is essentially with regard to pathway.

5. This Court also perused the complaints and since the dispute is essentially civil in nature, no positive direction can be issued as prayed for.

With the above observation, this petition is closed, with liberty to the petitioner to workout his remedies in the manner known to law.

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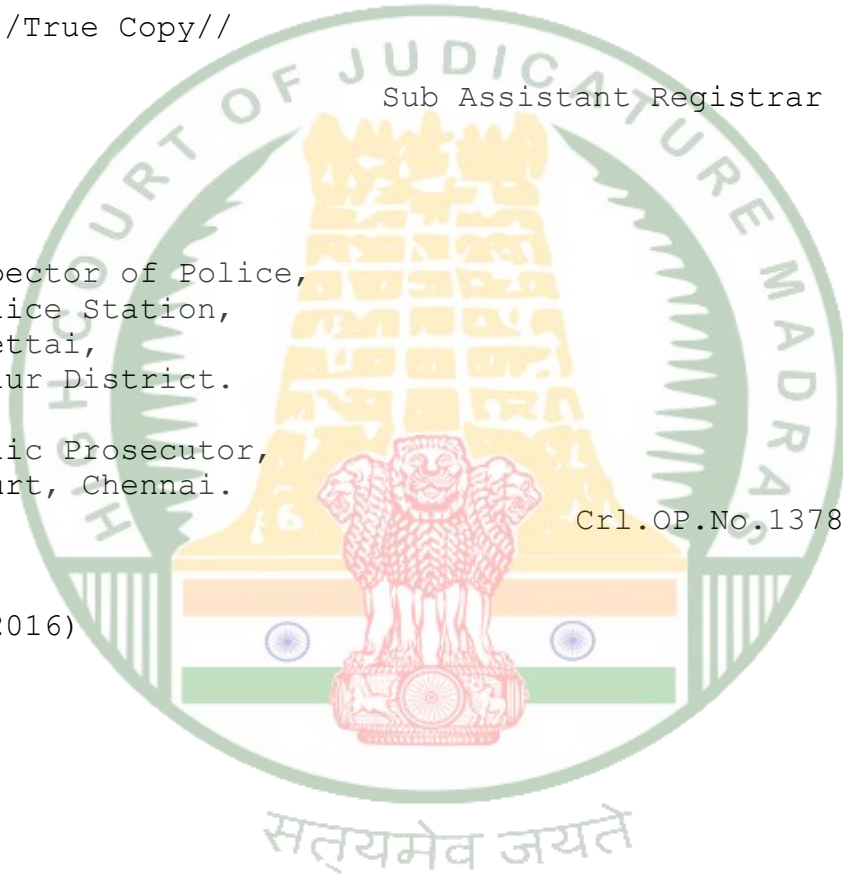
