Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for a Writ of mandamus directing the third respondent to grant permission to conduct the dance program scheduled to be held on 27.4.2016 at Sri Muthu Mariamman Temple Campus at Puliyampatti Mettuvalavu, Pulakkampatti Post, Sankagiri Taluk, Salem District.

ORDER

By consent, the main writ petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

2. Seeking permission to conduct cultural program on 27.4.2016 at Sri Muthu Mariamman Temple Campus, Puliampatti Mettuvalavu, Pulakkampatti Post, Sankagiri Taluk, Salem District, the petitioner made a representation dated 9.4.2016 to the third respondent. As the same has not been considered so far, the present writ petition has been filed.

3. I have heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Special Government Pleader, who has taken notice on behalf of the respondents.

4. Learned Special Government Pleader, on instructions, would submit that there is likelihood of law and order problem.

5. A mere apprehension cannot be a ground to reject the representation of the petitioner. There is absolutely no material before this Court to hold that there will be a law and order problem in the event of permission being granted.

6. In such view of the matter, the writ petition is allowed and the petitioner is permitted to conduct cultural program on 27.4.2016 at Sri Muthu Mariamman Temple Campus, Puliampatti Mettuvalavu, Pulakkampatti Post, Sankagiri Taluk, Salem District, however, with the following conditions:-

(a) The cultural program in connection with temple Festival at Sri Muthu Mariamman Temple, Puliampatti Mettuvalavu, Pulakkampatti Post, Sankagiri Taluk, Salem District, to be held on 27.4.2016 between 06.00 p.m. to 10.30 p.m.

(b) There should not be any kind of obscene dance or vulgar dialogue during the performance, by anyone of the participants.

(c) Double meaning songs should not be played so as to spoil the minds of students and youths.

(d) No dance or songs, touching upon any political party or religion or community or caste be played.

(e) No flex boards in support of any political party or communal leader be erected.

(f) The function should not affect either religious or communal harmony and shall be conducted without any discrimination based on caste.

(g) If there is any violation of any one of the conditions imposed, the concerned police officer is at liberty to take necessary action, as per law and stop such performance; and

(h) Similarly, the police is entitled to stop the dance program, if it exceeds beyond the permitted time.

Further, the third respondent is directed to issue necessary permission, incorporating the above conditions. No costs.
