2. There is no representation for the petitioner, perhaps, due to boycott of Courts. Heard the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

3. On the complaint dated 05.04.2016 given by the petitioner, petition enquiry is pending in C.S.R. No.423 of 2016. On a reading of the petitioner's complaint, it essentially appears to be a dispute between the petitioner and her sister-in-law with respect to certain financial transactions. Hence, no positive direction can be issued to the respondent police to register an F.I.R.

In the result, this petition is closed with liberty to the petitioner to work out her remedy in the manner known to law.

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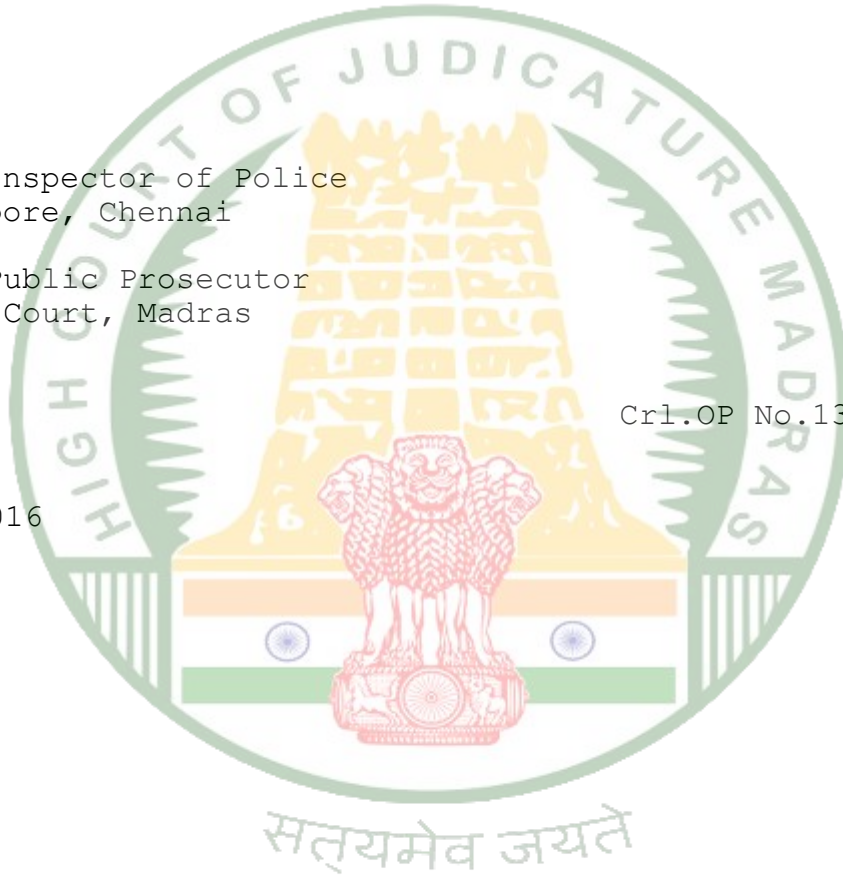
